

Qualifying Exam Doctoralstudents must pass a qualifying exam no later than semester following completion of 48 credits of coursework beyond Z o) degree At minimum, the exam will include a written dissertation proposal and oral defense by the dissertation committee. A written exam in the area of concentration may also be required or performance on the qualifying exam based on the judgment of the committee may result in the student failing the exam. If a student does not passon the first attempt, they may request n writing to repeat the exam. Students who fail the second time will be dismissed by the program.

PublicationRequirement-Thedepartmentrequiresthat all doctoral students have a paper accepted to a peer reviewed ournal or conference. Please discuss this with your advisor early as it can take six months or more to receive review comments back from a journal. Many faculty members in the department require their students to have more than one paper accepted.
