processisthe same for an Involuntary Withdrawal due toextenuating circumstances process and the SOCAT-Assisted Voluntary Withdrawal ("Voluntary Withdrawal") process; the latter only being awilable at USF campuses with a student outreta services of ice collaborating with SOCAT.

III. INTERVE NTION STANDARDS

Prior to moving forward with any steps in the withdrawal process dute extenualing circumstances, SOCAT mayoutreats to a students offer, or in some case require, a well-being check-rin appointment with aSOCAT member. During this appointment, the SOCAT member will discuss with the student the resources and service valiable that will assist the student in deceasing the student's behaviors of concentrand that will support the student in experiencing personal and academic susse Additionally, the SOCAT member will discuss with the student the option for a Voluntary Whidrawal as well asse SOCAT-Assisted with drawal. The options for support presented to the student to assist in achieving the student's academic and pesonal successor to assist in deceasing the student's concernition will be considered reasonable ptions under the circumstances without imposing an undue loss hip on the University or unacceptable risk of harm to self of the greater University Community

While SOCAT will make a goodaith attempt to monitor the student's engagement and follow-up with these resources it is the sole responsibility of the student oseek the supports envices. This includes seeking medical care or counseling, following three dical or treatment advice and accurately reporting one's physical and ental conditions to the student's heat care provider (s). SOCAT assistance in accessing these resources does not relieve a student of the student's personal responsibilitie follow through with and adhere to recommendations. A student's lacof follow through and engagement whits upport resources may result in

immediate temporary separation from USF which mayremain in place pending final determination of the Involuntary Withdrawalprocess. Thismay prohibit a student for attending lassesparticipating in registered student organizations or activities or entering any USF property, campus USF affiliated housing.

IV. IN VOLUNTARY OR VOLUNTARY WITH DRAWALS

- B. Involuntary Withdrawal from active course rerollment, will be initiated when the student's condition/behavior creates a ignificant and imminent risk to the safety, health and well-being of the University community. Such risk includes engagement in behavior that directly endanges others, significantly disrupts the community or poses a legitimate and iflethreatening concern for safety.
- C. Prior to invoking an Involuntary Withdrawal from classes in an effort to determine the nature, duration, and serity of the concern for safety and whether reasonable rediffications exist that would sufficiently mitigate the concern, SOCAT may:
 - 1. Require the student undergo aindividualized assesment at Student Hetta Services, which mayinclude 2-4 essions, by ticensedmental hetta practitioner. As part na

SOCAT will review the results of the assessment to determine whether reasonable supports will allow the student to meet the student's essential academic and University community responsibilities while maintaining a safe college environment for all students. The results of the mandated assessment and recommendations are not binding on SOCAT, the Designated Committee, Designated Authority or the University.

VI. APPEALS

A student hatheright to file a written appeal of OCAT's decisions garding an Involuntar Withdrawal or Reurn to Classes. The stdent mayappealin writing to the campus senior students uccess officer (e.g. Vice Resident of Studen Successor equivalent teab USF campus) or designee within (3) as of the date of the notice to the student. The senior students uccess officer will consider the written appeal and rendefinal decision within ten (10) day or notify the student that additional time will be necessary to consider appeal the senior student officer's decisions a final USF action.

- B. The appellætofficer may granta review of a SOCAT decision only if the appellætofficer determines one of the following:
 - 1. New evidence that was not available at the time of SOCAT's decision; or
 - 2 A significant deviation from procedures that affected the outcome of SOCAT's deliberations.
