This certilicate program teaches students how to integrate continuous improvement strategies in a global environment.

The curriculum includes coursework that covers Six Sigma, LEAN and statistical design models. Up to 12 hours of graduate certil-cate coursework may be applied to a graduate degree program with departmental approval.
