a. What is a reasonable accommodation?

Reasonable accommodations can be provided by departments, programs, and event organizers at the request of guests and visitors with disabilities mmodations that are considered reasonable are those that do not fundamentally alter the nature of the institution's programs and policies, and do not place an undue hardship on the
